






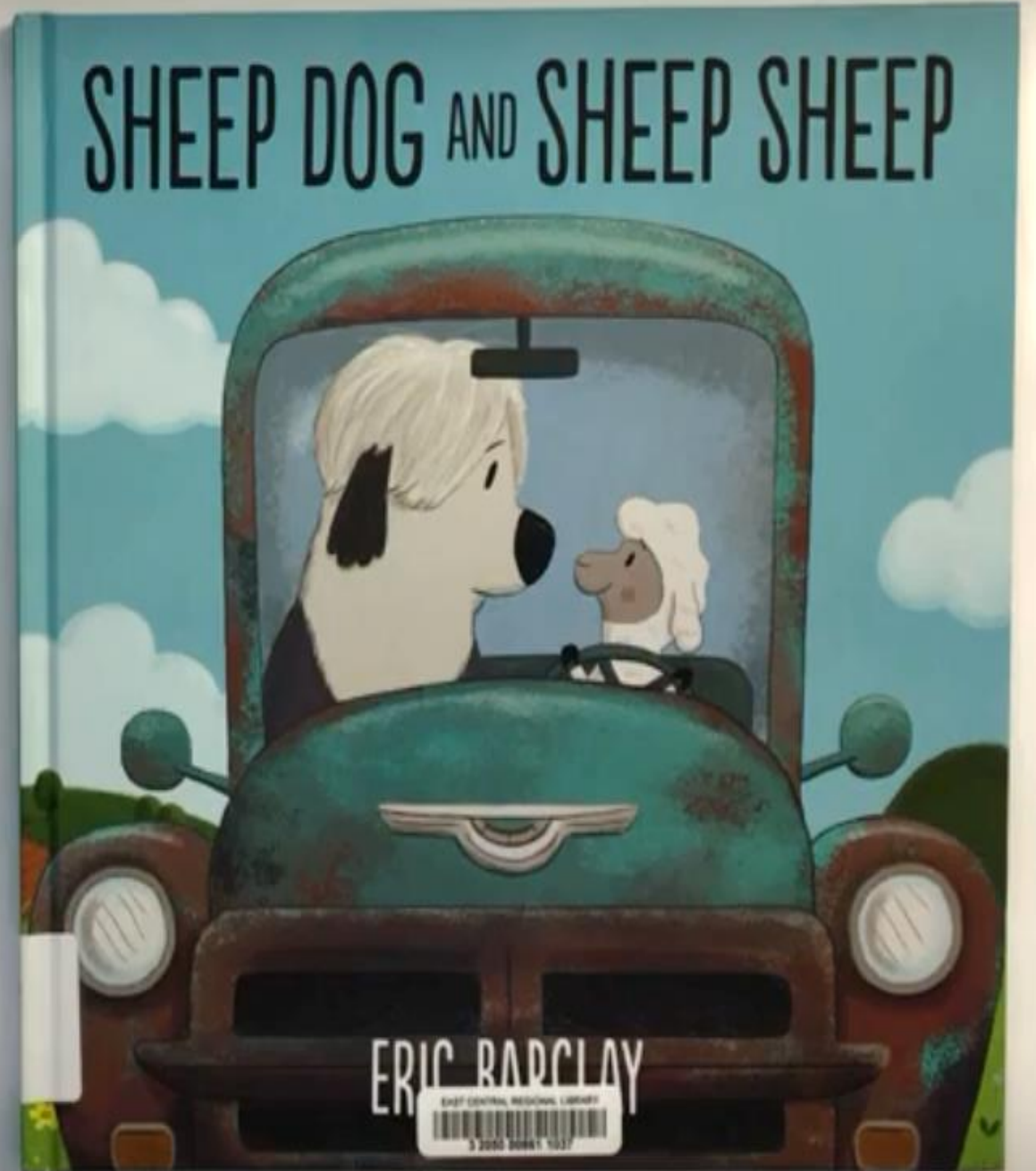

Be right back!"



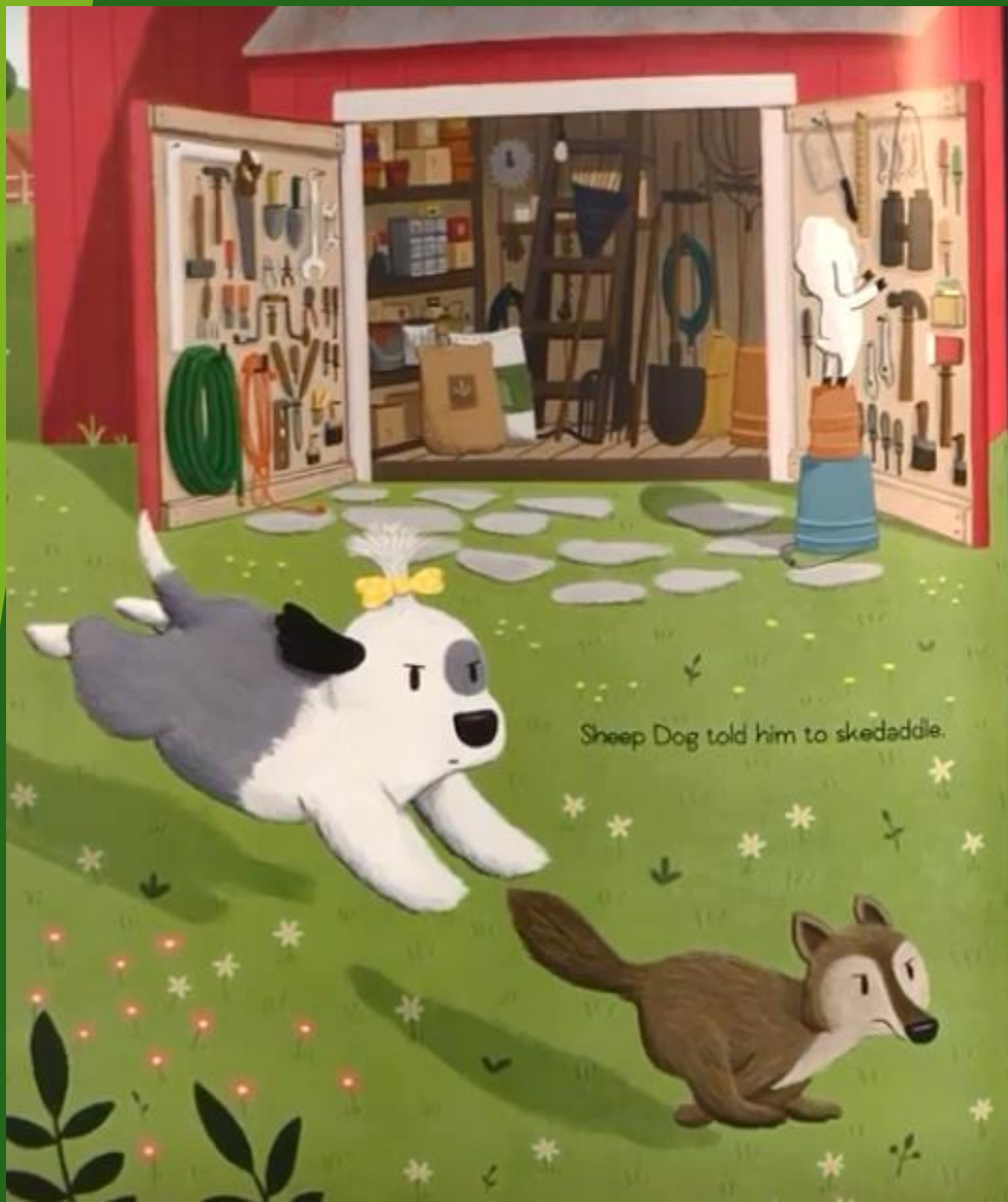
Sheep Dog looked around. It was true he could see a little better with his hair pulled up.

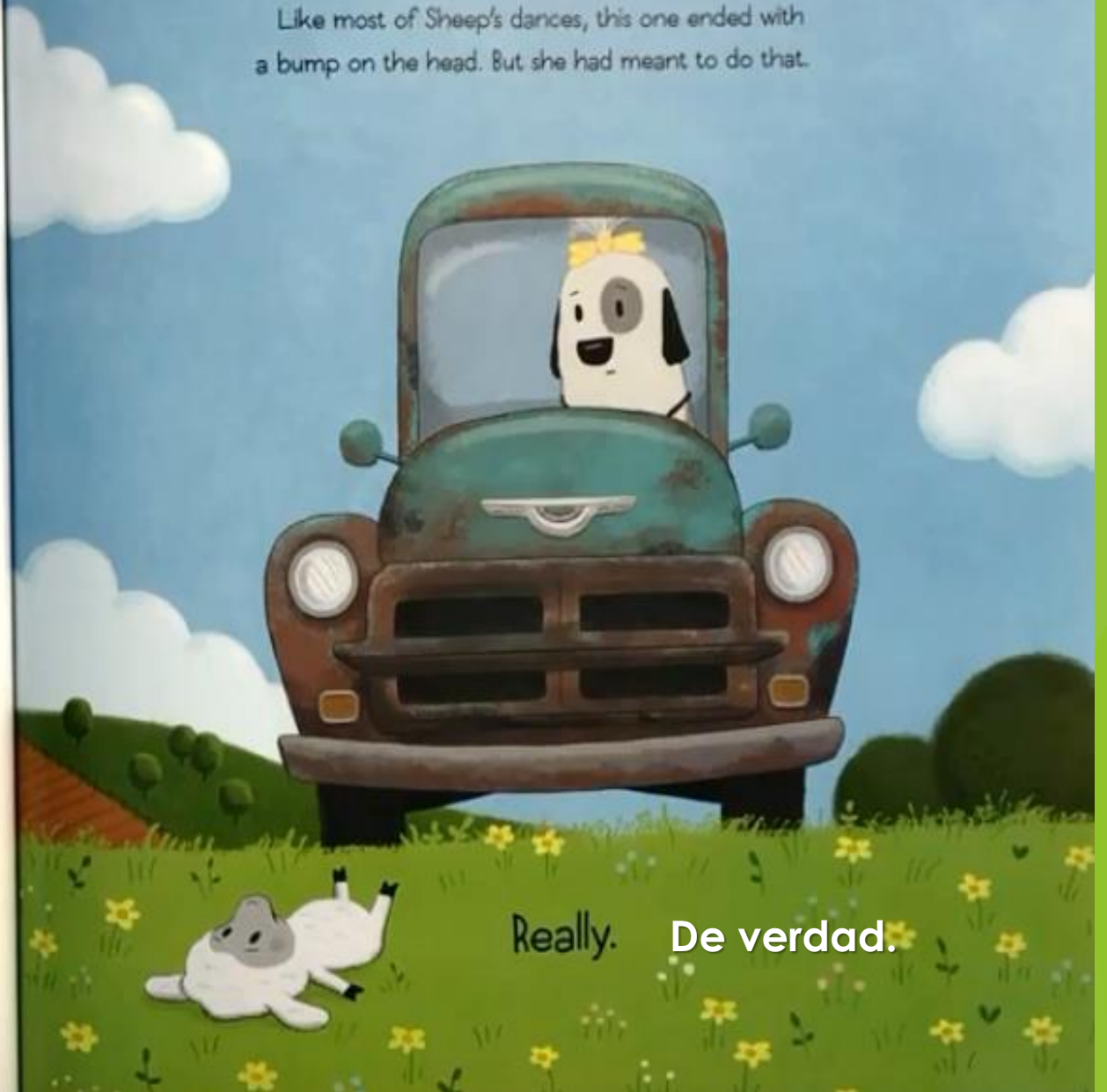
Sheep kept on dancing.

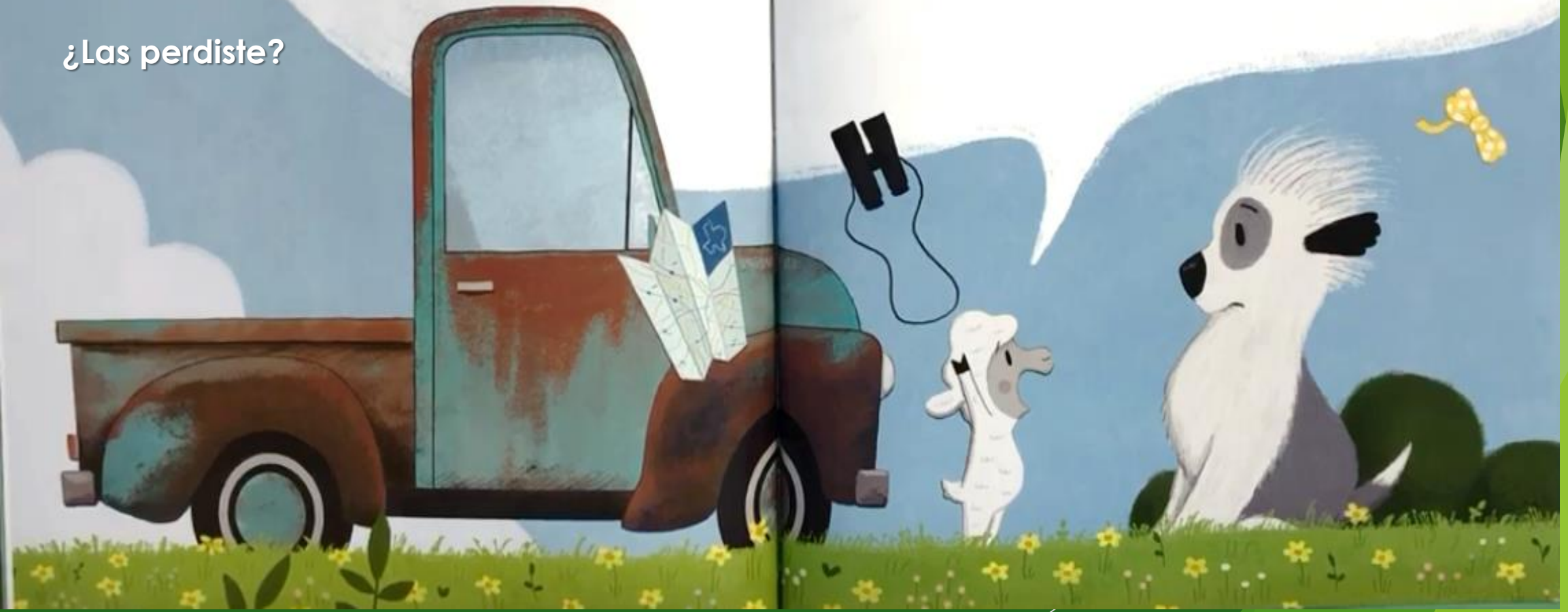

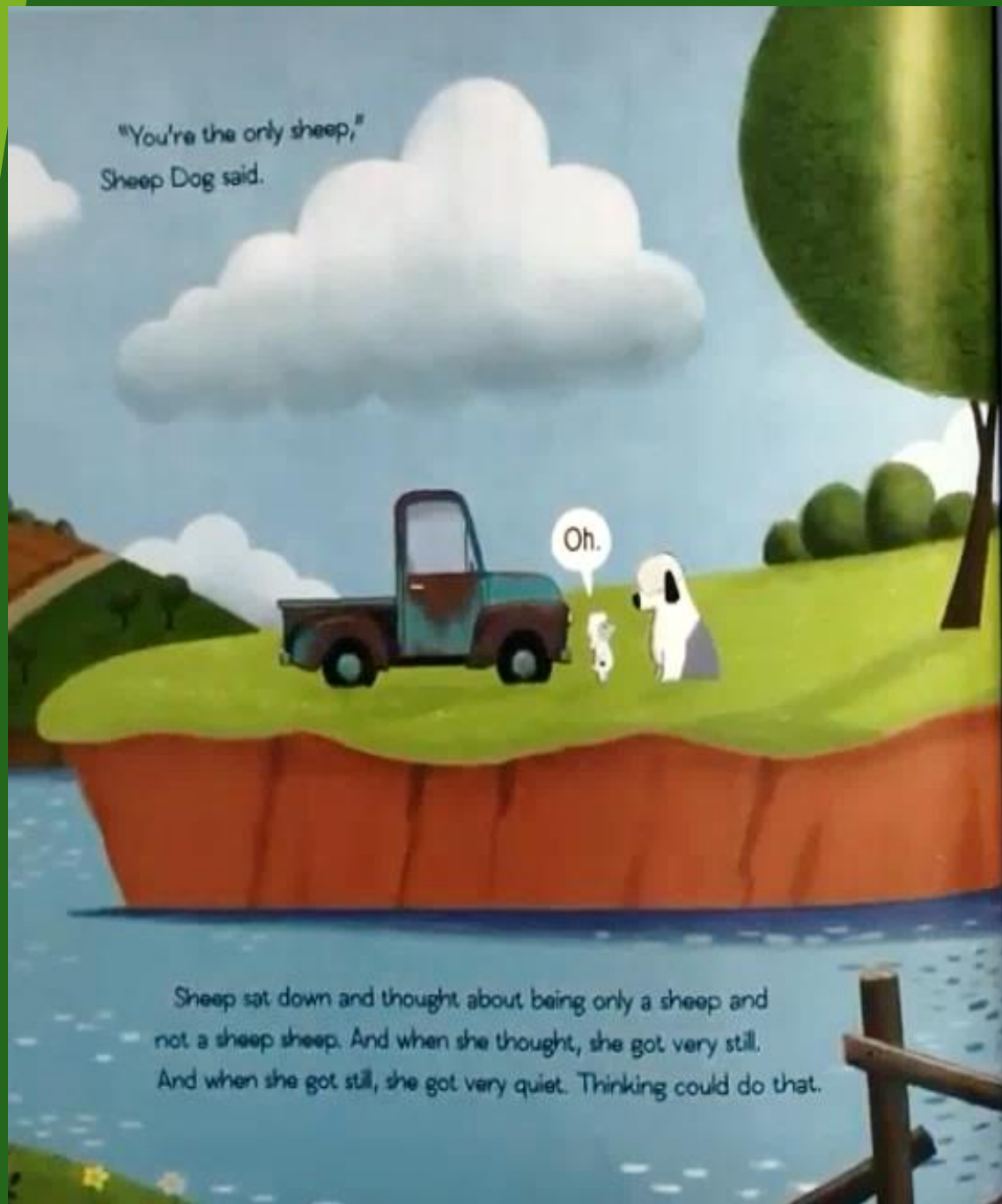

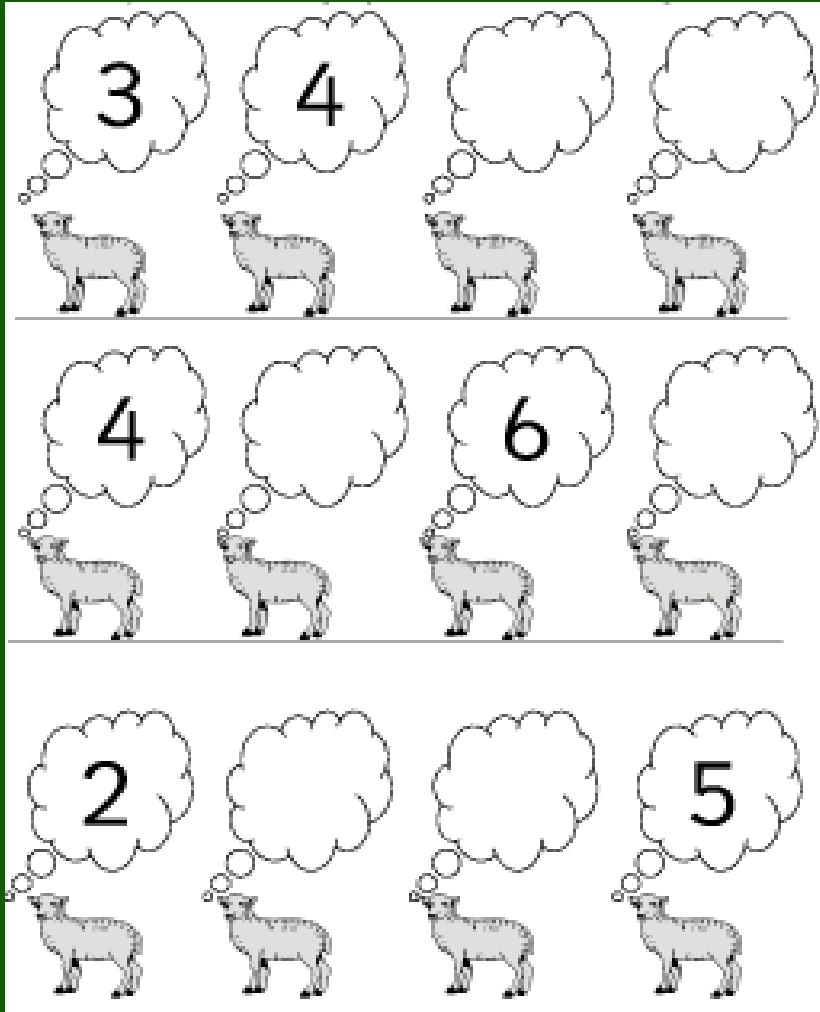
