BIRTHDAY CIRCLE

Children love the Montessori birthday circle. It is the highlight of every birthday. Celebrants get to share pictures of when they were born and each year of their life. They talk about memorable moments and milestones. Each month we send a celebration template form. We use this for our Montessori birthday walk around the sun. Tip: Create a birthday board with your child's birthday and your child's picture from birth to present.

OPTIONAL SNACK TREATS

The Question Game is a technique used to help children organize and share their own stories, first orally, and later in writing.

- The game begins after your child has been involved in an experience, for example; The child went to their grandparent's house to bake a cake for grandfather's birthday.
- The aim of the question game is to help children recall upon an event and answer questions in their appropriate context such as WHO, WHY, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE and HOW.
- After the experience begin by asking, "Who did you visit today?"
- Have your child recall the people, associating when we refer to a person or people we use the term 'who' 'l' and 'whom'.
- Then ask, "When did you go to your grandparent's house?" and "what did you do?", prompting to recall when the experience occurred, giving them a sense of time.
- Then ask, "Why did you go to your grandparents house?" prompting to recall the purpose of the experience (to make a cake for their grandfather).
- Repeat asking questions, giving help to recall if necessary.
- At the end of the question game summarize the experience, for example; "You went to Grandma and Grandpa's house yesterday to bake a cake for Grandpa's birthday" reiterating WHO, WHY, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE and HOW.
