To help prevent the virus from spreading:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick, except to get medical care.
- Eat healthy foods and drink plenty of fluids.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

Our school has been making sure that all students wash their hands for at least 20 seconds. That's singing "Happy Birthday" two times. Teachers have a special handwashing song too!

We remind children to use a tissue when they need to sneeze or touch their face, not lick surfaces, or put their fingers in their mouths. Please encourage your child to do the same at home. Best way to remind children to wipe their noses is to have them bring their own box of tissues at school.

We are also enforcing our sick policy. Students will be sent home from school for the following reasons:

- Fever (99.5 or higher)
- Vomiting or Diarrhea
- Persistent Cough
- Persistent Runny nose (if allergy related, will need doctor's note)
- Any nasal discharge other than clear
- Suspect of a communicable disease
- Rashes
- Other symptoms related to flu or other illnesses
