Morning and Afternoon Daycare

If you wish to drop off your child before 9:00 of pickup after 3:00, be sure to sign up for the a.m /p.m. daycare. Morning daycare fee from 7-9 a.m. is \$50 per month. Afternoon daycare is from 3-6 p.m and the fee is \$60 per month. AM and PM daycare is \$100 per month. The elementary day care fee are \$50 am, \$150 p.m. and \$200 am and pm. Be sure to drop off pick up your child at your scheduled time to avoid daycare fees. Daycare sign up is necessary to maintain proper staff-child ratio.

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Nap Bedding and Extra Clothes

NAP BEDDING:

To avoid contamination, please send all nap bedding in a pillow case or a small shoe sized plastic box. Nap bedding should not be exposed or touch other bedding. If you are using bags, please make sure that the bedding does not stick out. The plastic box or pillow case should fit your child's small blanket and crib sheet. Do not bring comforter sets or adult sized pillows.

EXTRA CLOTHES:

Please bring a set of extra clothes for your child, which includes, shirt, pants, socks, underwear. If your child is in the toddler class, please bring more. Put all extra clothes is a shoe –sized plastic container.

Label all items with your child's name. Bedding and the extra clothes box will be sent home on Fridays to wash. Be sure to bring clean bedding and the extra clothes box every Monday. Cubbies will be cleaned out every Friday.
